Individual Time Trial: 10K to 40K depending on category, see below for distance.

- Online Registration is at Bikereg.com up to two days before the event. ((Individual TT) Team Time Trial) .
- Teams may register for the TTT on Saturday at the race site.
- Participation by pre-registration only - No day of race registration
- Individual Time Trial □ Junior entry fee is \$10, all others \$20
- Team Time Trial □ Junior entry fee is \$10, (\$40 per team) all others \$20 per individual (\$80 per team)
- All riders must wear ANSI approved Helmets
- All riders must have a valid USCF licenses. No exceptions will be made. 1-Day and Annual Licenses will be sold on site the day of the event. Unlicensed riders who purchase a 1-day license may ride in their Age-group or as a Cat V but will not be eligible for State Championship medals or prizes.
- Registration for the Team time trial on Sunday may be made on Saturday at the event site.

Registration / Finish Line - The registration is at Royal High School, the start line is 2 miles NW of Royal High School in Pattison TX. The Start line is near the Early Childhood Development Center in Pattison at the intersection of 1458 and 359. Parking is at the High School. Order of events for TT:

START TIMES: Saturday, Aug 2, 2008

ITT first rider off at 7:30am and then at 30 seconds intervals.

TTT first team off at 7:30 am and then at 2 minute intervals.

RULES:

1. Riders must wear an approved helmet whenever on the bike.
2. You must register for and race the distance that your event is contested over to be eligible for a medal in that event. (example, an 18 year old junior would have to register for and race in both the 20km and the 40km ITT's to be considered for both a Junior 15-18 medal and in his/her category race)
3. You must obey all traffic laws and/or lawful orders from Law Officers.
4. Riders purchasing a 1-day license are restricted to Men Cat 5, Women Cat 4, or age-based Youths' or Juniors' race. In addition participants with 1-day licenses are not eligible for state championship medals.
